PROGRAM BASICS

The Hotel Program is a cooperative effort between Above + Beyond Cancer and participating hotels to provide overnight accommodations to cancer patients who must travel for outpatient treatment, but cannot afford a place to stay.

HOTEL PARTNERSHIPS

On a rotating basis, hotels provide complimentary rooms on a space-available basis.

ROOM RESERVATIONS

Rooms are provided Sunday through Thursday nights. Please provide as much notice as possible, but not less than five business days prior to the lodging dates.

4

EXPENSES

Expenses incurred while at the hotel such as parking, food, telephone calls, and/or movies are the responsibility of the patient.

MAKING A HOTEL REQUEST

Requests for lodging are managed on a first-come, first-served basis, during regular business hours. All requests for lodging are made by emailing: hotelprogram@aboveandbeyondcancer.org with your lodging needs. Only Above + Beyond Cancer staff can make a hotel reservation.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Cancer patients who are receiving a physician-approved cancer treatment protocol.
- Patients who have limited income (self-defined) and have no alternative housing options close to the treatment center.
- Patients who live at least 50 miles from the treatment center.
- Patients who are ambulatory and require no special services from the hotel.
